ALBERTA NATURAL GAS REBATE PROGRAM

We have been fielding a number of inquiries regarding the natural gas rebate program that the government of Alberta has implemented. The government stated that if the regulated (Direct/Apex) wholesale rate was higher than \$6.50 per GJ, a rebate would apply (November 2022 through March 2023). The Alberta Utilities Commission published the regulated rate submissions as follows:

November 2022: Apex-- \$5.32; DERS/ATCO -- \$5.641 (no rebate)

December 2022: Apex -- \$6.167; DERS/ATCO -- \$6.140 (no rebate)

January 2023: Apex -- \$6.446; DERS/ATCO -- \$6.446 (no rebate)

February 2023: Apex -- \$3.176; DERS/ATCO -- \$3.715 (no rebate)

Our wholesale natural gas provider is Gas Alberta Inc., and generally, their wholesale rates are lower than the regulated wholesale rates. Please note that we have not increased our rates, which the Board of Directors reviews regularly to ensure our system is maintained and upgraded to continue to provide you with safe, reliable natural gas.
