PROPERTY ACCESS

Property access has been an increasing issue for our staff. In order for us to inspect and maintain our infrastructure, we ask your assistance in providing us with gate codes, combinations, or keys. LEAK SURVEY / LINE WALKING

We have contracted GLD Projects Inc. (a gas leak detection company) to walk all of our gas lines in two areas of our franchise. They are now completing our Tap 6 area, which encompasses an area east of Highway 22, north of Dog Pound/Madden area, to approximately the Westcott Road and east to the main electrical transmission lines (excluding the Village of Cremona).

Within the next couple of weeks, they will begin walking all the gas lines in our Tap 8 area, which encompasses Water Valley, Little Red Deer Estates, Little Red Acres, The Siding, Ridgelands, Winchell Lake, and surrounding areas.

GLD will endeavour to contact all landowners in each area. They will be driving decaled vehicles and will be wearing safety vests. They will also put out CLGC sandwich boards in each area.

They will need access to our infrastructure up to and including the gas meter. They will NOT require access to the inside of your home.

As referenced in our previous newsletters, the Federal Fuel Charge increase, which was effective April 1, 2024, to \$4.095 per GJ is showing on this bill for your April gas consumption.

2024 METER CHANGES / RECERTIFICATIONS

Our staff are currently working on routine meter change outs. Any meter with a seal expiry date of 2024 will be changed out for recertification or removal of service. We will be working with you to schedule these appointments to allow us to relight any appliances as necessary. To eliminate the need for homeowner presence for appliance relights, we are installing meter bypass valves for future meter changes. Your cooperation in working with us to change out the applicable meters is appreciated.
