

PURPOSE:

CLGC wishes to contribute to our members and their family's success through a bursary program.

PROCEDURE:

The CLGC will provide an annual bursary in the amount of \$1,000 to a candidate who meets the following criteria:

- Is a current CLGC member or is a dependant of a current CLGC member,
- Is enrolled in a full-time trade, certificate, diploma or degree program in Alberta,
- Has demonstrated community involvement or leadership through participation in school and/or community activities.

Applications will be received until September 30 of each calendar year.

Applicants must provide the following information:

- First and last name
- Co-op member account number
- Co-op member name (if different than applicant)
- Current address
- Mobile phone number
- Email address
- Date you completed high school
- Post secondary school name and address
- The name of your program
- The program outcome (e.g. certificate, diploma, degree, Master's, Journeyman Certificate, etc.)
- The year of the program you will be in
- Your period of study Start and End dates
- Your School Student ID number
- A transcript of previous semester results or proof of enrollment
- Written demonstration of community involvement or leadership in the form of two reference letters from people who are not relatives of the applicant.
- Signature of Applicant
- If under 18, signature of parent or guardian

The successful applicant will be chosen at the October Board meeting annually. The bursary shall be presented at the CLGC Annual General Meeting each year. If the successful applicant is unable to attend the AGM, the funds will be mailed.
