ANNUAL METER CHANGES/RECERTIFICATIONS

Our team is currently completing routine gas meter change-outs. Any meter with a seal expiry date of 2025 will be replaced for recertification or removed from service as required.

If required, we will reach out to schedule individual appointments. During these appointments, our technicians will relight any appliances as needed once the new meter is installed.

To simplify future maintenance and reduce the need for homeowners to be present for appliance relights, we have been installing meter bypass valves during these change-outs. If you do not have a meter bypass on your current meter, we will upgrade it during our visit. This will help make future meter servicing faster and more convenient for everyone.

METER SITE INSPECTIONS

In addition to routine meter change-outs, our staff is also conducting meter site inspections and regulator maintenance at several locations throughout the franchise area. This ongoing work helps ensure the continued safety, reliability, and efficiency of our natural gas systems.

We kindly ask for your cooperation in providing unobstructed access to your meter and all related infrastructure. Clear access is essential for the safety of our operators—and for your safety as well.

Thank you for helping us maintain a safe and dependable system for everyone.

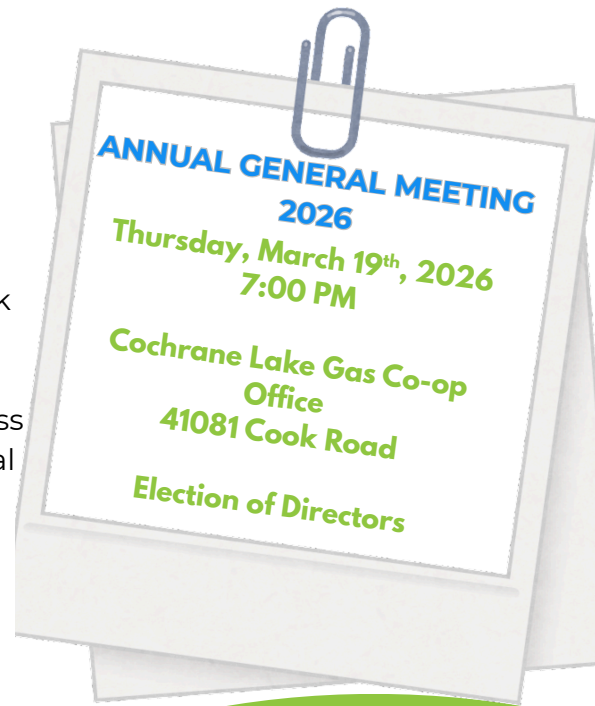

Winter Safety Tips for Natural Gas Appliances



As Mother Nature continues to gift us with winter temperatures, many households rely more heavily on natural gas appliances to stay warm. To help keep your home safe and your appliances running efficiently, here are a few important winter safety reminders:

- **Keep outdoor vents clear**

Snow and ice can block appliance vents, which may cause equipment to malfunction or shut down. After heavy snowfall or strong winds, check that all exterior vents, regulator assemblies, and meter areas remain clear.

- **Maintain proper ventilation indoors**

Natural gas appliances need adequate airflow to operate safely. Avoid storing items too close to furnaces, water heaters, or other gas-fired equipment, and ensure utility rooms are not overly crowded.

- **Install and test carbon monoxide detectors**

Carbon monoxide (CO) is colourless and odourless, making detection essential. Install CO detectors on every level of your home and test them regularly, especially during winter months when heating use increases.

- **Have appliances serviced annually**

A qualified technician should inspect natural gas appliances once a year to ensure proper operation, venting, and safety controls. Routine maintenance helps prevent unexpected issues during the coldest days of the season.

- **Protect your natural gas meter**

Keep your meter visible and accessible. Do not use sharp tools to remove ice, and avoid piling snow or outdoor equipment near the meter. If you notice damage or suspect an issue, contact us immediately.

- **Know the signs of a gas leak**

A strong sulphur or "rotten egg" smell is a key indicator of a possible leak. If you detect this odour, leave the area immediately, and call our office for assistance.

Staying proactive with these simple steps helps ensure a safer household. If you have any concerns about a gas leak don't hesitate to contact our office for assistance. We are available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week for emergencies.
