APRIL IS DIG SAFE MONTH

April is Dig Safe Month in Alberta — a reminder of the importance of safe digging practices and protecting underground utilities. Before starting any digging or ground disturbance, always remember to Click or Call Before You Dig.

Why Dig Safe Matters

Damage to underground utilities can cause serious injuries, service disruptions, costly repairs, and even fatalities. Taking a few simple steps before digging helps keep everyone safe.

How You Can Help

- Click or Call Before You Dig: Contact Utility Safety Partners (formerly Alberta One-Call) by calling 1-800-242-3447 or visiting www.albertaonecall.com before starting any digging activity.
- Respect Locate Marks: Stay clear of all marked utilities and never dig within the tolerance zone.
- Expose Conflicting Facilities: If buried facilities conflict, expose them before using mechanical excavation equipment.
- Dig With Care: Be aware of your surroundings and proceed cautiously at all times.
- Review Hazards: When working in high-risk areas, review utility locates and hazards with the excavator or contractor before ground disturbance begins.

Safe digging starts with planning — let's all do our part this Dig Safe Month.

GAS LINE LEAK DETECTION / LINE WALKING

Starting in May, our contractor will begin the annual Gas Leak Detection / Line Walking Program. This important program helps ensure the safety and well-being of our members while maintaining the integrity of our gas infrastructure.

More information will be shared soon, including details about property access, inspection areas, and what to expect during the process.
