GAS LINE LEAK DETECTION / LINE WALKING



We have contracted our annual leak detection and line walking program to K9 Leak Hunters for 2026. Their team will commence work the week of May 11th.

About K9 Leak Hunters:

K9 Leak Hunters is a leak survey company specializing in the detection and pinpointing of natural gas, oil, and water pipeline leaks using a highly trained detection dog combined with advanced gas sensing technology. They help pipeline operators, utilities, and infrastructure owners find leaks faster, with greater precision, and without disrupting operations. Their certified K9 team (Nala & Jay), are trained to detect trace-level hydrocarbon and water scents that traditional methods can miss. Each deployment is backed by real-time gas monitoring, GPS mapping, and digital field documentation, delivering dual validation and defensible results trusted by operators and regulators alike.

K9 Leak Hunters will be contacting landowners in advance to notify them when they will be on the property. While working in the area, they will be driving trucks with CLGC logos and will post temporary signage to indicate when work is taking place nearby.

When working on private property, they always aim to minimize disruption and ensure the safety of all animals. Canine Nala is a highly trained and very friendly working dog, but they recommend that landowners keep their own dogs contained while they are on site—particularly if there are livestock, guardian dogs, or may be protective or unfamiliar with visitors. This helps reduce any unnecessary risk and allows them to work efficiently.

For livestock, Nala is always under control on a lead, and they make every effort to maintain a respectful distance from animals in the field. If there are specific areas where landowners would prefer K9 not bring the dog—such as during calving season or around sensitive livestock—no problem at all. They will complete those sections independently while Nala remains safely secured in the vehicle.

K9 Leak Hunters goal is to work safely, respectfully, and collaboratively with landowners while completing the survey as effectively as possible.

CLGC kindly asks for your cooperation in allowing unobstructed access to our natural gas lines for inspection. This work is essential to maintaining the safety and reliability of our system.
